

RESOLUTION

RE: ACCEPT DONATION OF TRICERATOPS FOSSIL HEAD FROM MR. AND MRS. ROLAND MAPELLI AND FAMILY, AND AUTHORIZE DISPLAY IN THE CENTENNIAL COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Weld County Home Rule Charter, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of Weld County, Colorado, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has designated the triceratops the official Weld County fossil, and

WHEREAS, an actual fossil has been discovered in Weld County near Briggsdale on property owned by Mr. and Mrs. Roland C. Mapelli and family, and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Mapelli and family have had the head of the fossil restored and wish to donate it to Weld County, with the condition that it be displayed for the public in a County facility, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of Weld County to accept all donations by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, hereby accepts the donation of a triceratops fossil head from Mr. and Mrs. Roland Mapelli and family and authorizes its display in the Centennial Complex.
